

# HOW TO INSTAL FONT

## Windows 10

- Unzip the folder containing the fonts first. Fonts cannot be installed if they are zipped.
- Right click on the font file and select **Install**.

OR

- Search for **Fonts** in the search box by the start menu.
- Click on the **Fonts (Control Panel)** link to open the Fonts Manager
- Drag and Drop or Copy and Paste the unzipped fonts into the Fonts Manager to install.

## Windows 8

- Unzip the folder containing the fonts first. Fonts cannot be installed if they are zipped.
- Right click on the font file and select **Install**.

OR

- Go to search in the start menu.
- Search for **Fonts** in settings.
- Click on the **Fonts Folder** to open the Font folder.
- Drag and Drop or Copy and Paste the unzipped fonts files into the Fonts folder to install.

## How to Install Fonts on Mac Manually

You don't necessarily have to use Font Book to install new fonts on Mac. You can also do this manually by copying font files to Library/Fonts.

Unfortunately, starting from OS X 10.7, the Library folder and all its subfolders have been hidden from users sight. You'll need some extra effort to locate and access it:

- Open Finder and click the "Go" section in the upper menu.
- Find "Go to Folder" in the drop-down menu and click on it.
- Type "~/Library/Fonts" in the pop-up window and press "Go."
- The Fonts folder will show up.
- Drag and drop an unzipped font file to the Fonts folder.

Well done! Now you know how to add Mac fonts manually, too.
